TTO and VFP will jointly begin distribution of food starting March 16, 2020. Please bring your ID and come to the Community Connection Center (CCC) at 9 Court Street to receive a pre-packed box of food. There **WILL NOT** be onsite shopping held at TTO or VFP until further notice. TTO and VFP are working diligently to maintain a clean and safe environment for volunteers and clients. Please be mindful of social distancing (staying away from close contact with others) and try to be in and out of the CCC as quickly as possible as we work to reduce the spread of this virus.

REQUIREMENTS: A valid ID is needed to receive a box of food. These forms of ID are the same as you would provide during regular onsite shopping hours.
