This scholarship is available to provide financial assistance to graduating high school seniors impacted by cancer.

Award: Four (4) \$1000 scholarships

Eligibility Requirements

1. Graduating high school senior from Elk Point-Jefferson, Vermillion, or Dakota Valley
And:
2. A minimum of 1 of the 4 criteria:
 - Has an immediate relative (Mom, Dad, siblings, grandparents, aunts, uncles, cousins) who has/had any type of cancer
 - Pursuing a career in any medical field
 - Helping care for or helped someone with cancer
 - Has cancer or is a cancer survivor

Application

There is no application worksheet for this scholarship. Please include the following information using whatever format of documentation you prefer. Please include somewhere on your application paperwork your name, address, school, phone number and email address so we can contact you if you are chosen as a recipient.

- Common Scholarship Application (EPJ Students)
- Financial Need Statement
 - *If applicable, please include any financial information you can regarding medical bills or other expenses you have incurred due to cancer affecting a family member. If you have not had a family member affected, please include information on how you plan to pay for your college/why you need the financial support afforded by this scholarship.*
- Essay
 - *Tell us briefly why you feel you deserve this scholarship. How has cancer affected your life or why do you wish to pursue a career in the medical field?*

Selection based on:

- 1) Caregiver of someone diagnosed with cancer
Preference given to applicant who has/had cancer or who has an immediate family member who has or had cancer or someone who has cared for someone with cancer.
- 2) Financial need
- 3) Essay
