Graduation Reminders for Seniors & Parents

Graduation is Saturday, May 13, 2023 at 1:30pm at USD's Sanford Coyote Sports Center.

Doors to the Sanford Coyote Sports Center open at 12:30pm.

Seniors should plan to arrive between 12:30 and 12:45pm. They will receive instructions at graduation practice regarding where they will lineup.

It is recommended that seniors carry their mortar board (hat) and tassel into the building rather than to wear it. Tassel's have a tendency to fall off accidentally and get lost before the ceremony.



Graduation gowns should be removed from the plastic bag and either ironed or let hang several days in advance to allow wrinkles and creases to relax.

Graduation is a formal ceremony. We recommend that your student wear an appropriate dress shoe, a collared shirt and slacks for the gentlemen. For the ladies, heels should be an appropriate length for walking comfort and traversing a few steps up and down from the stage. A skirt or slacks are appropriate for the ladies.

The only adornments to the graduation gown or hat that will be permitted are those issued by VHS (honor cords), VHS organizations such as National Honor Society (stole) or the prior approval of appropriate Native American beading of the cap or wearing of an eagle feather.

Review of 2023-24 Class Schedules

Scholarships

Scholarships are now available. Now is the time to have your student stop into Student Services and regularly check their email for more information. Most deadlines are in March so it's important to have your student complete, review, and submit their scholarship application before the deadline. If your student has questions about scholarships and/or would like assistance with completing a scholarship application, please have them stop into student services. If your student needs a recommendation for their application, please remind them to ask for those recommendations as soon as possible so it allows people time to prepare them.



FAFSA

The 2023-2024 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is available now!. FAFSA can provide your student with grants, loans, and work study funds from the Federal Government. It is best to get it done early since some of the funds are available on a first come first served basis. For a short video on how to fill out the FAFSA form, please click here. To fill out your FAFSA form, please visit the FAFSA website. Please contact student services if you have questions about filling out the FAFSA or your student would like help in filling out the FAFSA.

What are the deadlines for filling out the FAFSA form?

To be considered for federal student aid for the 2023-24 award year, you can complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form between Oct. 1, 2022, and 11:59 p.m. Central time (CT) on June 30, 2023.

Any FAFSA form corrections or updates must be submitted by 11:59 p.m. CT on Sept. 10, 2023. However, many states and colleges have earlier deadlines for applying for state and institutional financial aid, use Find your state's deadline. Check with your college or career school about its deadlines. Because of the variation in state and college deadlines, it's highly recommended that you fill out the FAFSA form as soon as you can after Oct. 1 to ensure that you don't miss out on available aid.¹
