Vermillion Tanagers Homecoming Parade Rules & Regulations

1. **Parade Date is Friday, September 29, 2023.** Parade starts at 1:30 p.m. **Parade Line-up** starts at 1:00 p.m. at the **Vermillion High School**. More specific information will be sent to participants within the week of the parade.
2. All entries must be approved by the Parade Coordinator, Kamden Dibley, prior to the parade, and by the Parade Managers on-site, Lenni Billberg, Kamden Dibley, and Trisha Fisher.
3. All applications should be received no later than **Monday, September 25**, to be eligible for the parade. Email or mail applications to Kamden Dibley, Vermillion High School, Vermillion, SD 57069 or Kamden.Dibley@k12.sd.us .
4. **Driver of parade entry must be 21+** with valid SD Driver's License & must show proof of insurance on the day of parade.
5. No floats with the following: obscenity, references to drugs, alcohol, tobacco, or violence.
6. No political or election-related entries.
7. Entries must reflect the theme, be in good taste, and be deemed school-appropriate the day of the parade by the Parade Manager.
8. No candy allowed.
9. No animals are allowed.
10. Participants are responsible for cleaning up after themselves after the parade.
11. Participants will be financially responsible for any damage done to other floats or private or public property before, during, or after the Parade.
12. Participants may not load or unload vehicles en route.
13. Any participant displaying behavior that is deemed unsafe or inappropriate by VHS staff and/or law enforcement will be asked to leave all parade activities immediately and will not be allowed to return to the parade.
