## The Time Is Now.

If your senior plans on attending college in Fall 2024, it is time for them to start applying for scholarships. If your student has applied to a college, university, or technical school, and been accepted, make sure to check that school's website for scholarship deadlines and have



your student apply, even if they have not decided which postsecondary institution they would like to attend. This, along with any available aid, can help a student determine what school would be most advantageous to attend. Have your student stop into student services if they have questions about where to find scholarships, need help applying, would like a reference, and/or would like help with their essay. Listed below are some of the South Dakota schools and their scholarship pages and deadlines:

<u>University of South Dakota</u> - Priority deadline November 15, final deadline December 1, 2023.

South Dakota State University - Priority for Summer and Fall 2024 is given to applications received on or before December 1, 2023.

<u>Dakota State University</u> – Priority date to submit your application is March 1, 2024. <u>Black Hills State University</u> - Deadline to submit the New Student scholarship application is February 1, 2024.

Northern State University - Deadlines vary. <u>Lake Area Technical College</u> - Deadlines vary. Mitchell Tech - Deadlines vary.

# Spring Dual Credit

The application for registration for dual credit is now open. Registration for classes will begin on Friday, November 10.

Dual credit gives eligible students the chance to accelerate their education by enrolling in classes to receive both high school and college credit. You can find our dual credit basics document, along with other important information, on the dual credit webpage at SDMyLife.com.

#### **FAFSA**

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form is normally available in October of each year, but the 2024-25 FAFSA form will not be available until sometime in December 2023. They are working on making some major changes and improvements to simplify the process for students and parents when filling out the form. Changes to the FAFSA form for the 2024-25 aid year include expanded eligibility for federal student aid and a more streamlined application process. There is not a definitive launch date set yet, but when there is, the VHS Student Services office will communicate the date with senior students and parents.

What are the deadlines for filling out the FAFSA® form?

#### **Federal Deadlines**

#### 2023-24 Academic Year

The FAFSA form must be submitted by 11:59 p.m. CT on June 30, 2024. Any corrections or updates must be submitted by 11:59 p.m. CT on Sept. 14, 2024.

### **College Deadlines**

Each college may have its own application deadline. Check with the college(s) you're interested in attending. You may also want to ask your college about its definition of an application deadline. Is it the date your FAFSA form is processed or the date the college receives your processed FAFSA data?

However, many states and colleges have earlier deadlines for applying for state and institutional financial aid. Check with your college or career school about its deadlines. Because of the variation in state and college deadlines, it's highly recommended that you fill out the FAFSA form as soon as you can after Oct. 1 to ensure that you don't miss out on available aid.1
